

# Using Overdrive with a Tablet

1. On your device, open your browser and go the library web site – [www.lincolntownshiplibrary.org](http://www.lincolntownshiplibrary.org). Tap the box that looks like this:



2. The Overdrive Web site for Southwest Michigan Library Consortium will open. Find a link for free software called Overdrive Media Console, usually at the bottom of the page. Tap “install,” “accept,” and “download.”



3. You may also go to the Apple App Store for iPad or iPhone and download the application OR you may go to the Google Play store for Android. If you are using an Amazon Kindle, you will need the Kindle application.



4. Find the new Overdrive Media Console app on your device and tap “open.” The first time you open Overdrive Media Console on your device you will be asked to sign in with your Adobe ID.
5. If you don’t have an Adobe ID, tap the option to create one. This will take you out of the app, and onto the Adobe Web site via your browser. Follow the instructions on the Adobe Web site to create your free Adobe ID. This is a necessary step. You cannot open and read eBooks without an ID. Your ID will be your email address and a password that you create. Remember to write it down in case you have to reinstall the Overdrive app in the future.

6. After you have finished creating an Adobe ID, go back to the Overdrive Media Console app. You may have to open it again. Sign in with your Adobe ID. If the sign-in screen is no longer up, go to “settings” and put your Adobe ID and password in and tap “authorize.” Now your Android device is ready to accept eBooks and mp3s.
7. Either access our library’s Overdrive catalog through the application or go back to the Overdrive Web site for Southwest Michigan Library Consortium with your browser.
8. Our library purchases extra titles for our patrons, so be sure to sign in right away. What is available to you may be more than what you see on the screen as a general user. Tap the sign in option is at the top of the page. Select our library from the list in the pull-down menu. Enter the number on the back of your library card.
9. Browse, sort or search for a book


